



BANNOCK BRAE ESTATE CATHY'S ROSÉ

TASTING NOTES - 2008 Vintage

This rosé is “purpose built” meaning that it is crafted as a specific style rather than the “saignée” method consisting of bleeding off wine from an existing fermenter. It has a full mid-palate, and produced in a dry style.

It is crafted solely from our own Estate grown Pinot noir grapes and has a full vibrant nose of berry fruit (especially strawberries) with confectionary undertones.

The taste is surprisingly full for a rosé. The clean finish ensures the drinkability of the wine, which is exactly the desired result for a wine designed to be enjoyed at the beach or lake-side with lunch on a hot summer's day.
